___ Safe Salon Concepts	C. Sanitary Materials Area used to set aside a specific place for implements and materials used during services
___ "Levels of Clean"	D. Distilled water, pouches, verification strips
___ Salon PPE	E. Multiple chronic conditions described by conditions that last longer than one year
___ Ongoing sterilization expenses	F. Service steps consisting of greeting and seating, consultation and analysis
___ Iatrogenic injury	G. Sanitization, disinfection and sterilization
___ Aseptic professional practices	H. Home care recommendations, assistance in leaving, reappointing, taking payments
___ SMA	I. Gloves, masks, protective eyewear and protective barrier clothing
___ NCQ	J. A wound caused during a service, whether purposefully, such as in surgery, or accidentally
___ Foot analysis steps	L. Injury, infection or inflammation
___ Dismissal steps	M. Putting the safety and health of your client ahead of performance of a cosmetic service.
___ The three "I" conditions	N. New client questionnaire with health questions used to make proper recommendations prior to all services
